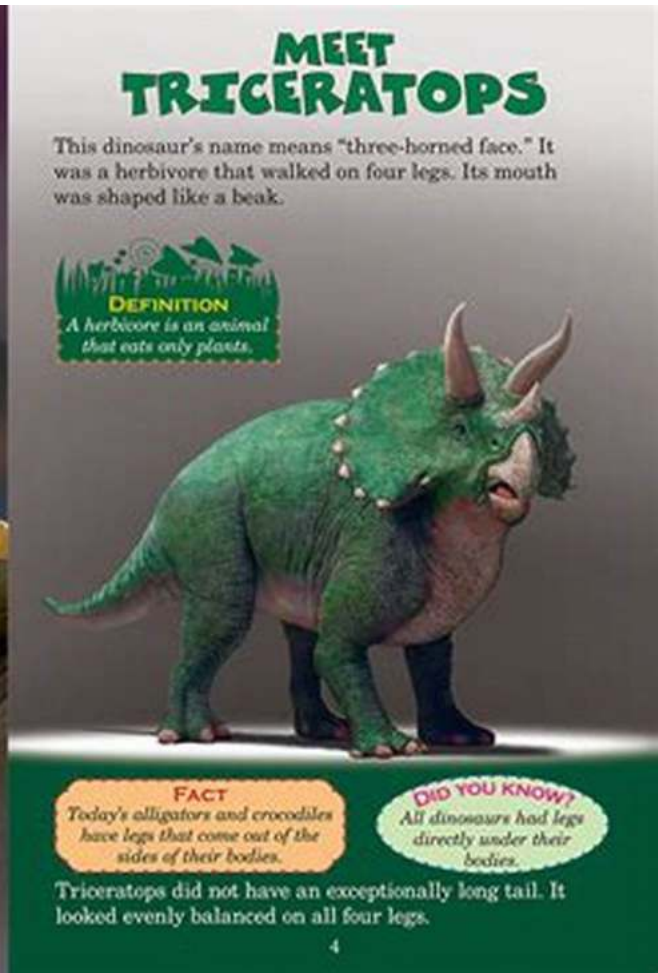


Triceratops Vs Spinosaurus: Who Would Win?

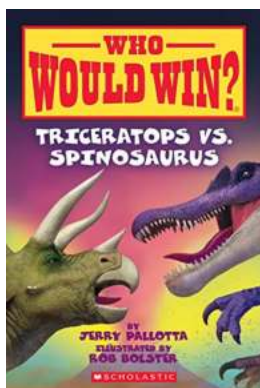
